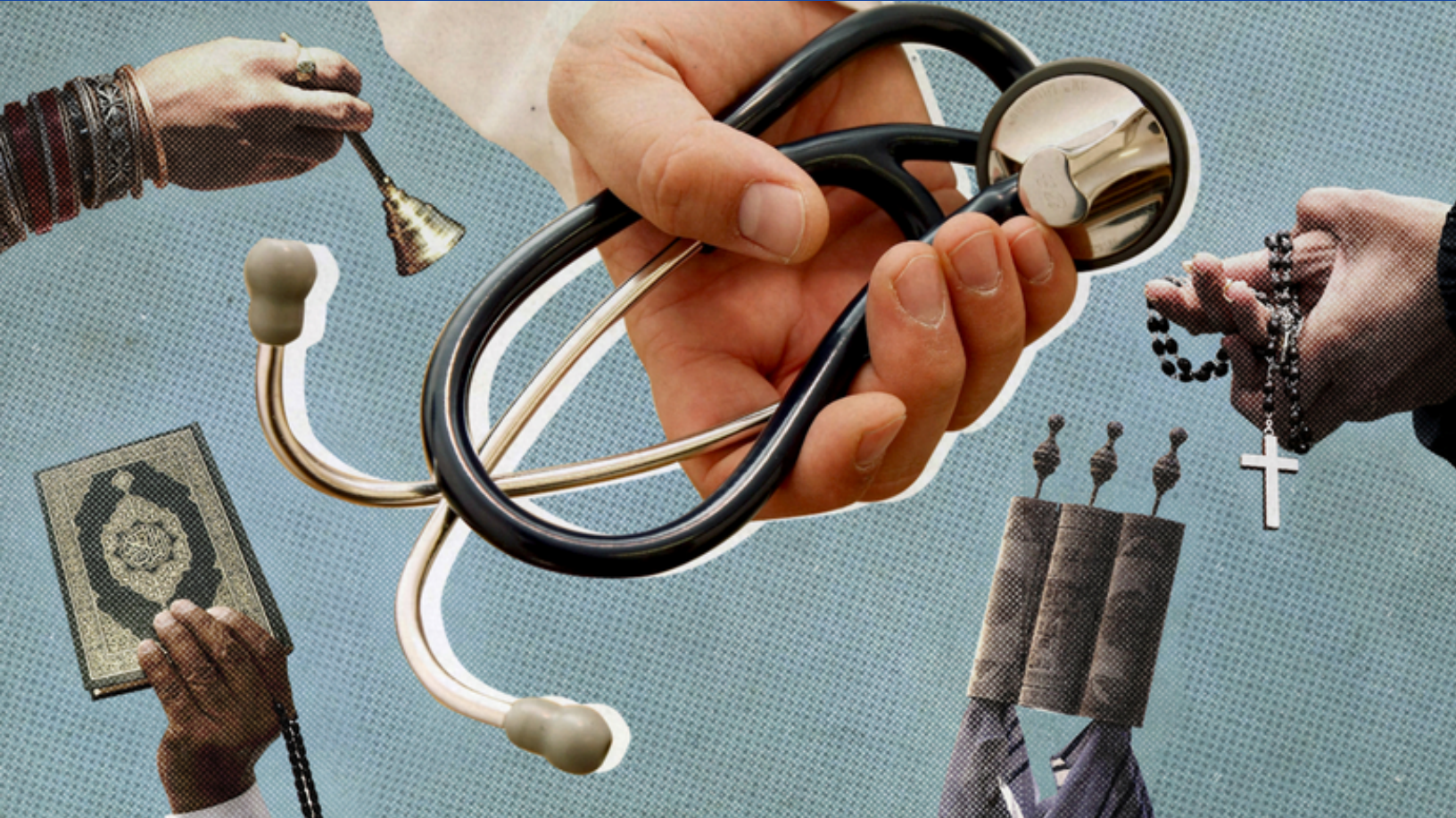


RELS 255: Religious Diversity in the Healthcare Fields
